The School

The teenager programme takes place in our four story traditional building. It has 10 classrooms with interactive whiteboards, a library, a students' area with computers, WIFI, vending machines and a wonderful roof terrace to relax under the sun!

Spanish lessons




There are four Spanish classes every morning from 9:30 to 13:30, which focus on communication skills. We offer 6 different levels according to the Instituto Cervantes curriculum which is based in the Common European Framework (CEF).



We want to help our students speak with confidence, regardless of level, in a fun and friendly environment.

Activities and excursions

The programme of activities and excursions will help our students discover Spanish culture, the friendly attitude of the Spanish and the festive atmosphere of our city.

Every afternoon there will be activities from 16:30 to 20:30 They include cultural visits, sports competitions, barbecues, dancing lessons, beach afternoons or shopping. Students return home after the activities.

On Saturdays, there are full-day excursions, while on Sundays, the teenagers are free to spend the day with their hosts, or they can meet friends (as long as they tell their hosts where they will be and when they will be back).

Experienced teachers and co-ordinators take care of our students and accompany them during all the cultural activities, visits and excursions included in the programme.

Accommodation

Students live with carefully selected host families or in a residence in the city centre.

The host family houses are comfortable and hospitable. Most of the families live near the school, the maximum distance from the school to the home is 20 minutes by public transport.

The residence has place for 60 students, meals are taken in the residence cafeteria. There's school staff on site available 24h.

Students normally have double or triple rooms in families or single or double rooms in residence including full board. Lunch can be packed or hot.

Weekly laundry and cleaning is included.

Students will be given a 20 ride bus/metro pass per week, extra rides are payable by them.

→ Host family

ideal for students who wish to immerse themselves as much as possible in the Spanish culture.

Students will enjoy a family atmosphere where only Spanish is spoken.

→ Residence

in the city centre, just 15 minutes walk from the school.

Single or double rooms with private bathroom and comfortable common rooms for students.

Supervision and security

Every outing is supervised by the school staff, who watches out for the well being and safety of the students. Specific activities (ex. sailing, paragliding, etc.) are supervised by professional instructors.

Students are expected to attend lessons and activities as scheduled. Students have to respect the programme curfew that is established depending on the age.



Your arrival



Arrival and departure

Arrivals are normally on Sundays and departures on Saturdays (extra nights might be possible at extra cost). We pick up the students at the airport and take them to the host family or residence.

On departure students are picked up at their accommodation and driven to the departure terminal of the airport. They will be helped to do the check-in and will be guided up to the passport control before the departure gates.

Students who have booked the UM service with the airline (unaccompanied minor service) will also have to book the service with the school (extra cost) as the airline requires the person in charge to escort the student until boarding the plane.



The first day

On Monday morning host families accompany the teens to school and show them the way back home, either walking or by public transport.*

Students living in residence will be accompanied on Monday morning by our school staff.

Students will then take a level test so that they can be placed in the class of the corresponding level. After the test, they will attend a Welcome meeting where they will receive useful information and get to know other new students and the staff of the school.

Once the tests have been marked, every student is placed in a group and the classes can begin.

Complete beginners of Spanish don't have to take the level test but will participate in the Welcome meeting.

* It's possible to book the "extra supervision service" if parents want the host family to accompany the children everyday to school and pick them up in the evening after the activities.

The programme includes

- Special programme for students between 14 and 17 y.o.
- Spanish course in groups of 10 students maximum.
- 20 classes per week (55 minutes per class).
- Class material.
- Level test.
- Certificate and academic report at the end of the course.
- Host family accommodation in double room with full board or accommodation in residence in single or double room with full board.
- Activities, cultural visits and sports every afternoon from Monday to Friday.
- One full-day excursion per week.
- Return transfer from Valencia airport.
- 20 weekly rides by bus or metro.
- 24-hour emergency assistance.
- Travel insurance.
- Supervision by our experienced team of teachers and coordinators.
