YOU TELL US

All InTuition courses are personalised around each student's needs, priorities and preferences.

- **Do you have a special reason for studying?**

The more we understand about the student and their goals, the more effectively we can select the right host tutor to deliver the ideal programme.

- **Where do you want to study?**

We have hundreds of host tutors across the UK, Ireland, Malta, the USA and Canada, as well as in France, Germany, Italy and Spain.

- **When do you want to begin?**

We are open 365 days a year: courses can start on any Sunday. Most students study between one and four weeks, but longer and shorter programmes are easy to arrange.

WE PROPOSE

We use the information provided by the student to match them with a host tutor. Students receive a full profile, showing the host tutor's skills, experience and professional background, as well as their home, local area and family. Feedback from previous students is also provided.

After students confirm their host tutor and course dates, they're ready to go!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What will I do in my spare time?

All InTuition courses include spare time – it's important to have the chance to relax, both for the student and the teacher! Students also have homework which needs to be completed outside lesson time.

Young Learners aged 10-13 are supervised 24 hours a day – they are not permitted independent free time outside their host tutor's home. During the afternoons when they don't have a formal activity, they spend their time as a member of the host family, doing whatever their host family is doing: it could be shopping, going to the park, or just relaxing at home.

Young Learners aged 14-17 may be permitted independent free time, depending on the 'house rules' of their host tutor family. Their host tutor sets out the rules (including where they may go and what time they must be home) and treats them as if they were one of their own children.

All our host tutors live in safe areas where it is appropriate for teenagers to have independent free time without supervision

How do I know I will get on with my host tutor family?

We choose our host tutor families carefully. The number one thing we look for – other than quality of teaching – is their ability to offer a warm and friendly welcome to all students who come into their home. This means that it is very unlikely that any student won't get on with their host tutor family – in fact, in most cases they quickly become very good friends.

Which excursions and activities can I choose?

Host tutor families know what interesting things there are to do in their local area. When students arrive, they can discuss the different excursion and activity options nearby, and make any requests. If students have a specific excursion or activity they really want to do while on their course, we take that into account when placing them with a host tutor family.

Who will meet me at the airport? How will I recognise them?

When students arrive, they are met at the airport either by a member of their host tutor family or one of our taxi drivers – we confirm this information when a course is confirmed. In both cases, students simply need to look out for their name written on an InTuition arrival board – their driver will be holding one. If they have any problems, we are always available on our 24-hour support line.

Course Information

Dates: Standard arrival is on Sunday afternoon/evening and departure on a Saturday morning. The first lesson is on Monday, unless otherwise requested.

Age Restrictions: Students aged 10-17 are welcome to apply for our Young Learner programmes.

Students aged 10-13 are required to choose a Fast Track (25 hours per week) programme. They receive 15 hours' formal lessons and 10 hours' crafts, games and other activity-based learning, as well as standard afternoon and weekend excursions.

Students aged 14-17 may choose any programme.

Two-to-one Courses: These are offered at a 20% discount on the one-to-one price per person. Students must have similar English levels. Prestige Homestay is charged per bathroom, not per person, so is not subject to a discount. A separate rooms supplement of £75 / €105 / \$90 per week applies should separate rooms be required.

English and Sport or Culture: includes 10 hours' tuition and three afternoon sport or culture sessions per week. Students can choose from the following options:

- Tennis or Badminton
- Golf
- Horse Riding (additional supplement of £100 per week applies)
- Sailing
- Rowing
- Local history
- Arts
- Music

J2J: Students are matched with a partner of a different nationality and first language, carefully selected to match ages, interests and levels of English. The J2J Programme is for 14 to 17 year-olds with a level from Elementary to Upper Intermediate. Students must be flexible on location.

J2J 2019: course start dates Sunday 23 Jun – 18 Aug

Please Note: A J2J booking must be made by 01 May to guarantee a partner. If InTuition is not able to find a partner within the 7 day time limit prior to the start date, we will provide a standard General English Classic 1:1 course for the J2J fee. For bookings received after 01 May: if no partner is found, standard 1:1 fees will apply. We may also place the student in a 3:1 arrangement if the two other students are of different nationalities.

English for Parent and Child: Ideal for parents who want to accompany their child and share lessons. Depending on student levels, lessons can either be shared 2:1 or taken 1:1 in parallel. Where separate 1:1 lessons are required, we aim to host students in two-teacher families or will arrange for a visiting tutor to teach either the parent or the child as required.

Exam Preparation: We provide intensive preparation for the Cambridge Assessment series of exams, as well as TOEIC and TOEFL. We are registered Trinity Selt (ISE) training provider). Preparation exams for other exams are available upon request.

Super Short Courses: A highly intensive choice for busy students. Courses can start any day of the week – including weekends. Fees are set for all locations – no City or Prestige Homestay supplement applies.

Academic English: Designed for Academic and Higher Education students, including those studying for the Prepa, Matura, Maturita or Abitur. The course aims to enable the trainee to develop and practise the special skills and formal language required to achieve academic success.

Academic Subjects: Tuition for GCSE, A-level or IB students in selected subjects:

- Sciences
- Mathematics
- Economics
- Humanities
- Arts and Music

Tuition Only: 1:1 or 2:1 tuition offered without full-board accommodation. Courses are offered in minimum blocks of 15 hours which can be taken in shorter sessions: as little as 1.5 hours at a time is permitted.

Edinburgh Festival: All courses taken in Edinburgh during the Festival period (28 Jul – 31 Aug) are charged a supplement of £150 per week.

Christmas / New Year: All courses starting between 22 – 31 Dec are charged a one-off (not weekly) supplement.

Dietary Requirements: We always do our best to accommodate special dietary requirements. However, we reserve the right to ask for a contribution of £50/€60/\$70 per week from the student if this involves the host tutor purchasing special ingredients (e.g. gluten-free products).

Unsocial Arrival / Departure Times: Students arriving or departing a host tutor's home between 22:00 and 06:00 will be charged a supplement of £30 / €30 / \$45.

Accompanying Adult: Accompanying persons receive room and board only.

Terms and conditions

1. Payment

For courses booked 20 or more working days before the course start date:

- A non-refundable deposit of £150/ €200/\$240 is payable immediately on course confirmation
- All outstanding fees must be paid no more than 10 working days before the course start date

For courses booked fewer than 20 working days before the course start date:

- All fees must be paid immediately on course confirmation.

Students will not be allowed to start their course unless full payment has been received by InTuition Languages Ltd (ITL), on behalf of the host tutor, by the stated due date.

2. Cancellation Policy

The cancellation fees detailed above will also apply to all courses which are not cancelled by written communication with ITL within the period stipulated.

Fees are not reimbursed if a student arrives late or departs before the end of the course.

If a course is cancelled or postponed after the course start date, fees will not be reimbursed.

3. Postponement

Students may postpone a course up to 10 working days before the course start date for a fee of £75 / €100 / \$120. The course must be rebooked at the same time in order not to incur cancellation fees. Postponing a course fewer than 10 working days before the course start date will incur full cancellation fees.

4. Visas (UK and Ireland only)

ITL will provide the documentation required for students to apply for a Short Term Study visa where necessary, upon receipt of full fees. If a visa application is unsuccessful, we will refund fees in full (less a £150/ €150 administration fee) upon receipt of the visa refusal letter (GV51).

5. Liability and duty of care

ITL acts only as agent between students (and their appointed agents) and host tutors. Under no circumstances can ITL be held responsible for any injury, damage, loss, delay or accident which may occur during a student's stay with a host family, or as a result of activities they take part in during their stay, or while travelling to and from the host tutor's residence. Lessons missed by students due to illness or absence will not be refunded. Neither ITL nor any host family is responsible for students' personal possessions.

Host tutors exercise a professional duty of care over all Young Learner students. This means that they may do what is reasonable in all circumstances for the purposes of safeguarding or promoting the student's welfare. In rare circumstances (such as where a student is unable to return to their normal country of residence) this duty of care may be extended beyond the arranged course end date. Our safeguarding policies can be seen in full at intuitionlang.com/policies-and-procedures.

No Young Learner student may travel to their country of study without ITL having first received a signed Parental Consent Form. Both parents / guardians must provide their consent for the student to travel and study, unless sole parental responsibility has been granted.

6. Insurance

Insurance cover is provided as standard for each Young Learner course where the student is ordinarily resident in the EEA or Switzerland. It covers against course cancellation, personal injury, loss of belongings and personal liability. For full information, please visit intuitionlang.com.

If a student is not ordinarily resident in the EEA or Switzerland, insurance cover is not provided. Students must arrange suitable travel insurance to cover them for the duration of their course.

7. General

ITL endeavours to place students in their region(s) of choice wherever possible, but reserves the right to place students in another location if there is no compatible family in the preferred region(s). ITL also reserves the right to change an allocated teacher before or during the course if this becomes necessary. In the unusual event of a host tutor not being available, ITL reserves the right to recommend a homestay with one family and lessons with an outside teacher.

ITL cannot accept any retrospective claim or complaint from a student. Problems must be brought to the attention of ITL during a course. We will seek to manage and resolve any problem brought to our attention during the course with extreme delicacy and tact and will, if necessary, move a student to a new Host Tutor with a minimum of disruption. Please note that notification of any problem is the responsibility of the student or his / her agent.

In the event of the discovery of any serious health problem or contagious illness, mental or physical disability, or special education need not disclosed at the time of booking, or criminal or anti-social behaviour on the part of a student, ITL reserves the right to terminate a course and repatriate that student at their own cost and without refund of fees.

8. Preparation for your trip

Students should ensure that their host tutor knows their estimated time of arrival (if a transfer has not been booked through ITL) so that he or she can make sure to be at home when the student arrives.

Students arranging transfers through ITL must provide airport / station arrival and departure times in advance.

We recommend that Young Learner Students bring at least £100/€100 pocket money per week.

9. Privacy

ITL takes the security of student and host tutor data very seriously. Both students and host tutors have obligations under UK and EU law to ensure the security and proper usage of data which is shared with them during the enrolment process, and during a course of study.
