

## HOW IT WORKS

### YOU TELL US

All InTuition courses are personalised around each student's needs, priorities and preferences.

- **Do you have a special reason for studying?**

The more we understand about the student and their goals, the more effectively we can select the right host tutor to deliver the ideal programme.

- **Where do you want to study?**

We have hundreds of host tutors across the UK, Ireland, Malta, the USA, Canada and Australia, as well as in France, Germany, Italy and Spain.

- **When do you want to begin?**

We are open 365 days a year: courses can start on any Sunday. Most students study between one and four weeks, but longer and shorter programmes are easy to arrange.

### WE PROPOSE

We use the information provided by the student to match them with a host tutor. Students receive a full profile, showing the host tutor's skills, experience and professional background, as well as their home, local area and family. Feedback from previous students is also provided.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What will I do in my spare time?

All InTuition courses include spare time – it's important to have the chance to relax, both for the student and the teacher! Students also have additional work assigned, which needs to be completed outside lesson time.

Students have two afternoons or evenings a week where their host tutor will accompany them on a local excursion or activity, taking into account the student's interests and preferences.

Outside of these times, students are welcome to relax in their host tutor family's home – perhaps catching up on emails or other work – or take the time to explore the area independently. Host tutors will provide full support with using public transport, and other expert guidance about what is available to see and do where they live.

### How do I know I will get on with my host tutor family?

We choose our host tutor families carefully. The number one thing we look for – other than quality of teaching – is their ability to offer a warm and friendly welcome to all students who come into their home. This means that it is very unlikely that any student won't get on with their host tutor family – in fact, in most cases they quickly become very good friends.

### Who will meet me at the airport? How will I recognise them?

When students arrive, they are met at the airport either by a member of their host tutor family or one of our taxi drivers – we confirm this information when a course is booked with a transfer service. In both cases, students simply need to look out for their name written on an InTuition arrival board – their driver will be holding one. If they have any problems, we are always available on our 24-hour support line.

### What happens at the end of my course?

At the end of each course, host tutors prepare an End of Course Report which tells students what they have studied, how much they have improved, and what they need to do to continue improving their English. Students also receive a certificate of attendance via email shortly after their course finishes.

InTuition Vis-a-Vis® online tutoring helps students continue developing their language skills after they return home.

# Course Information

**Dates:** Standard arrival is on Sunday afternoon / evening and departure on a Saturday morning. The first lesson is on Monday, unless otherwise requested.

**Two-to-one courses:** These are offered at 20% discount on the one-to-one price per person. Students must have similar English levels. Prestige Homestay is charged per bathroom, not per person, so is not subject to a discount.

**A separate rooms supplement of £75 / €105 / \$90 per week applies should separate rooms be required.**

**Experience Summer:** 2-week 2:1 summer programme: Students are matched with a partner of a different nationality or first language, carefully selected to match English levels and interests. The programme is open to students aged 18-21 with an English level from Elementary to Upper Intermediate.

Please note: An Experience Summer booking must be made by 01 May to guarantee a partner. If InTuition is not able to find a partner within the seven day time limit prior to the start date, we will provide a standard General English Classic 1:1 course for the Experience Summer fee. For bookings received after 01 May: if no partner is found, standard 1:1 fees will apply. We may also place the student in a 3:1 arrangement if the two other students are of different nationalities.

**University Preparation:** A two- to four-week introduction to the UK with a professional EFL tutor and family. Designed for international students who will study at university level in the UK, the course combines Academic English with a cross-cultural induction programme to help prepare international students for successful integration in UK university life.

**English for Parent and Child:** Ideal for parents who want to accompany their child and share lessons. Depending on student levels, lessons can either be shared 2:1 or taken 1:1 in parallel. Where separate 1:1 lessons are required, we aim to host students in two-teacher families or will arrange for a visiting tutor to teach either the parent or the child as required.

**Exam Preparation Courses:** We provide intensive preparation for the Cambridge Assessment series of exams, as well as TOEIC and TOEFL. We are a registered Trinity Selt (ISE) training provider. Preparation courses for other exams are available upon request.

**English for Work:** A generalised business English course, with a focus on developing the language required for the modern office workplace. Students requiring content tailored to a particular industry or job role should take a Professional English course.

**Professional English:** Our executive programme for business people and professionals with specific needs related to their job. Students are matched with host tutors with a professional knowledge of their industry.

**Super Short Courses:** A highly intensive choice for busy students. Courses can start any day of the week – including weekends. Fees are set for all locations – no City or Prestige Homestay supplement applies.

**Super Short Course 1 (2 nights / 3 days): 15 hours' tuition £675**  
**Super Short Course 2 (3 nights / 4 days): 20 hours' tuition £905**

**English Plus:** Students may exchange tuition hours for additional excursion / activity hours with their host tutor. Activity materials are not included in the standard price and are quoted after needs assessment.

**English for Teachers:** Designed for EFL or ESL teachers. The course focuses on developing tuition skills and knowledge, as well as building communication skills and classroom English. Students are matched with a host tutor who is experienced in delivering teacher trainer programmes. Flexibility of location is required.

**Academic English:** Designed for Academic and Higher Education students who need to study in English for their graduate studies. The course aims to enable the trainee to develop and practise the special skills and formal language required to achieve academic success.

**Tuition Only:** 1:1 or 2:1 tuition offered without full-board accommodation. Courses are offered in minimum blocks of 15 hours which can be taken in shorter sessions: as little as 1.5 hours at a time is permitted.

**Edinburgh Festival:** All courses taken in Edinburgh during the Festival period (28 Jul – 31 Aug) are charged a supplement of £150 per week.

**Christmas / New Year:** All courses starting between 22 – 31 Dec are charged a one-off (not weekly) supplement.

**Dietary Requirements:** We always do our best to accommodate special dietary requirements. However, we reserve the right to ask for a contribution of £50 / €60 / \$70 per week from the student if this involves the host tutor purchasing special ingredients (e.g. gluten-free products).

**Airport Transfers:** Please see Transfer Information.

**Unsocial Arrival / Departure Times:** Students arriving at or departing from a host tutor's home between 22h00 and 06h00 will be charged a supplement of £30 / €30 / \$45.

**Accompanying Adult / Child:** Accompanying persons receive room and board only. Fees exclude the cost of child care (if applicable) at £15 / €15 / \$20 per hour.

## Terms and conditions

### 1. Payment

For courses booked 20 or more working days before the course start date:

- A non-refundable deposit of £150/ 200/\$240 is payable immediately on course confirmation
- All outstanding fees must be paid no more than 10 working days before the course start date

For courses booked fewer than 20 working days before the course start date:

- All fees must be paid immediately on course confirmation.

Students will not be allowed to start their course unless full payment has been received by InTuition Languages Ltd (ITL), on behalf of the host tutor, by the stated due date.

### 2. Cancellation Policy

The cancellation fees detailed above will also apply to all courses which are not cancelled by written communication with ITL within the period stipulated.

Fees are not reimbursed if a student arrives late or departs before the end of the course.

If a course is cancelled or postponed after the course start date, fees will not be reimbursed.

### 3. Postponement

Students may postpone a course up to 10 working days before the course start date for a fee of £75 / €100 / \$120. The course must be rebooked at the same time in order not to incur cancellation fees. Postponing a course fewer than 10 working days before the course start date will incur full cancellation fees.

### 4. Visas (UK and Ireland only)

ITL will provide the documentation required for students to apply for a Short Term Study visa where necessary, upon receipt of full fees. If a visa application is unsuccessful, we will refund fees in full (less a £150/ €150 administration fee) upon receipt of the visa refusal letter (GV51).

### 5. Liability

ITL acts only as agent between students and their agents and host tutors. Under no circumstances can ITL be held responsible for any injury, damage, loss, delay or accident which may occur during a student's stay with a host family, or as a result of activities which they take part in during their stay or whilst travelling to and from the student's home, or loss of property. Lessons missed by students due to illness or absence will not be refunded. Neither ITL nor the host family is responsible for students' personal possessions.

It is an explicit condition of enrolment that students accept full financial responsibility for any damage caused by them to the host tutor's property during a course.

### 6. Insurance

Neither ITL nor host tutors provide insurance cover for adult students, and it is a condition of attending an ITL courses that students obtain personal travel insurance against cancellation, accident, illness or loss of property. All European Union students travelling within the EU are advised to register for the European Health Insurance Card, as well as arranging insurance cover.

Insurance cover is provided as standard for each Young Learner course taken in the EU where the student is also ordinarily resident in the EU. It covers against course cancellation, personal injury, medical, loss of personal belongings and personal liability. ### 7. General

ITL endeavours to place students in their region(s) of choice wherever possible, but reserves the right to place students in another location if there is no compatible family in the preferred region(s). ITL also reserves the right to change an allocated teacher before or during the course if this becomes necessary. In the unusual event of a host tutor not being available, ITL reserves the right to recommend a homestay with one family and lessons with an outside teacher.

ITL cannot accept any retrospective claim or complaint from a student. Problems must be brought to the attention of ITL during a course. We will seek to manage and resolve any problem brought to our attention during the course with extreme delicacy and tact and will, if necessary, move a student to a new Host Tutor with a minimum of disruption. Please note that notification of any problem is the responsibility of the student or his / her agent.

In the event of the discovery of any serious health problem or contagious illness, mental or physical disability, or special education need not disclosed at the time of booking, or criminal or anti-social behaviour on the part of a student, ITL reserves the right to terminate a course and repatriate that student at their own cost and without refund of fees.

### 8. Preparation for your trip

Students should ensure that their host tutor knows their estimated time of arrival (if a transfer has not been booked through ITL) so that he or she can make sure to be at home when the student arrives.

Students arranging transfers through ITL must provide airport / station arrival and departure times in advance.

We recommend that adult students bring at least £100/€120/\$150 spending money per week to cover transport and entrance fees (both yours and those of the host tutor) during activities and excursions.

### 9. Privacy

ITL takes the security of student and host tutor data very seriously. Both students and host tutors have obligations under UK and EU law to ensure the security and proper usage of data which is shared with them during the enrolment process, and during a course of study.
