#### **Course content**

Students follow a daily programme of 15 lessons of English language in the morning, while afternoons are spent learning outside of the classroom through exciting activities with new friends.

During the afternoon, students can choose from a number of sports and arts activities, with something for everyone. Sports can include tennis, football and basketball. Arts activities can include t-shirt painting, sketching, and performance arts.

Study trips are also a big part of the course, with one full-day and one half-day trip to places of interest in the UK included every week. Example trips include: a full-day trip to London for a Shrek Adventure and a walking tour and Brighton including the Brighton i360, the famous Pier and the Lanes. Half-day trips include Windsor Castle.

Students practise their English inside and outside of the classroom, for the best learning experience.

In the evenings, Discover English students will have an activity programme with a mix of sports, art and crafts, and other activities such as quizzes and film night.

#### Course content

Students enjoy English lessons in the morning and activities with professional coaches conducted in English in the afternoon.

Students are always learning and practising their English, while having fun, and developing other important life skills such as team-work and confidence.

Qualified English language teachers teach 15 lessons every week, and professional coaches deliver training for six hours a week in the chosen activity. Students can choose from performing arts, football, adventure\*, or swimming at IH Frensham Young Learner Centre. View English + across all our centres for other activity options.

Students will select an activity every week or focus on one activity for their stay. Students can be any level in their chosen activity, so they can improve on a skill or learn a completely new one.

Study trips are also a big part of the course, with one full-day and one half-day trip included every week. Examples include: Windsor Castle, London with a Thames boat cruise and royalty walking tour, and Brighton including the Brighton i360, the famous Pier and the Lanes.

There are on-site evening activities organised by IH staff every night, including fashions shows, discos, film nights, and treasure hunts.

#### **ADVENTURE**



#### **Course content**

Unlike our other Young Learner English programmes, this course has English lessons in both the morning and in the afternoon: 21 lessons of English tuition per week by a qualified English teacher. It is an intensive course across English reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.

It is not all hard work though — Intensive English classes are lively, interactive and fun. Students are encouraged to speak English at all times, and benefit from using the language with others their own age in different social situations.

Students will have 15 lessons of general English with the rest of the school then six additional lessons focused on improving their spoken English with a speaking exam at the end of their course.

Students also participate in sports, arts and crafts, and other activities. Aimed at practising English through fun and teamwork, the Intensive English programme proves that it is possible to work hard and still have fun!






